



WORKSHOPS

Each year, MUSICA International Association leads several **workshops** aiming in a first time to allow you to discover this research tool. It represents years of meticulous work on thousands of choral scores. Then we shortly suggest you to improve yourself the quality and the quantity of the data of the Musica International database of choral music repertoire.

These workshops are organized by the members of MUSICA International themselves and supervised by the international coordination team. Participants read through choral music scores, enter new data into the database and/or correct and improve already existing records. More exactly:

- **Conductors** input their favorite pieces;
- **Publishers** input their publications;
- **Composers** input their compositions;
- **Librarians** input the content of their library;
- **Musicologists** are especially welcome to work on scores of their speciality.

We also complete other features such as--

- appropriate keywords for an efficient search;
- the level of difficulty for both conductor and choir to learn and perform;
- the musical themes which are keyed in to allow display and direct searching when only a tune is known etc.

When possible, multimedia features like "Image of the first page" of the score, "Sound of an excerpt" from a good interpretation, correct pronunciation of the text (sound file), translations of the text in different languages, are also handled. The MUSICA workshops are open to conductors, documentalists, musicologists and all other volunteers endowed in specific domains involved in the project Musica (linguistic, multimedia, etc.)

During the Musica International workshops you will spend fascinating moments supervised by a dynamic and competent team.
